## PLANTATIONS

Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary has several Eucalyptus Plantations containing over 40,000 gum trees. These trees feed more than 50 koalas that call the Sanctuary home as well as the close to 500 sick, injured and rehabilitating wild koalas admitted through Currumbin Wildlife Hospital annually. Koalas will eat new and mature leaves, buds, flowers and at times bark, however the bulk of their diet consists of the soft, fresh leaf tips.

## INTERESTING FACT

There are at least 900 species of Eucalyptus trees in Australia. Koalas are known to eat around 30 of these.
